

## Second Statement

To Be Added To My Original Protest/Complaint Distributed on 9/29/06

I arrived at the studios of KPFT between 4 and 4:30 pm. Mike Martin entered the lobby proclaiming he had forgotten about the election until Susan Young had just reminded him about it on the phone, and that he had only one name on his Nomination Petition. He asked for my signature, I refused.

As the announced deadline of 5 pm was approaching, I was present to witness Duane Bradley approach Tucker Bradley and tell her that the deadline needed to be moved to 6 pm because that was the time the office at the station closed. After vacillating, she agreed and Duane made an announcement advising of the deadline had been changed to 6 pm.

I saw Emmett Abati Doe come into the conference room and after turning in his Election Packet , we talked about all that was being done to get Mike Martin qualified briefly.

Abati turned to address Tucker and asked her what time she had, she looked at her computer screen and said "the computer says it's 5:05".

Meanwhile, efforts continued at a frantic pace calling people to fax their written signatures in [I was never offered KPFT's fax machine o use but had to solicit signatures for my Petition at KPFT sponsored events] the Nominations flooded in, but was long after 5:30 PM.

At 6 pm I heard Tucker Bradley and her daughter invited to dinner at a local eatery by Susan Young (as I recall) along with Mike Martin, Melinda Iiey-Dohn, and Deb Shafto. Mike Martin added "we'll go and discuss strategy." Tucker never said a flat no; she vacillated from NO TO YES AND BACK TO NO, but I never heard her protest or issue any warnings.

I did not follow them so I cannot attest to anything after they all left the station together.

This is true and correct to the best of my recollection.
